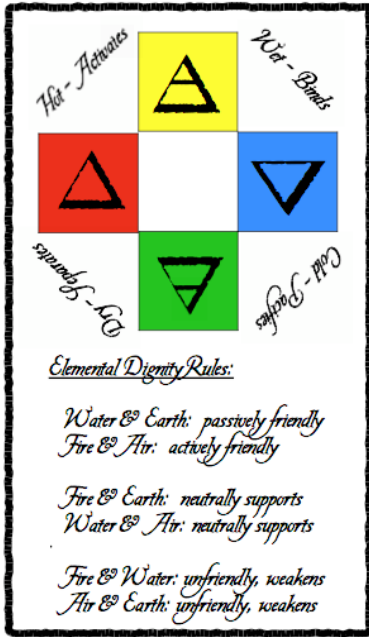

The general divinatory meaning of the four suits of the minor trumps is as follows, but each card has a separate meaning to be considered later:

| Wands  | Cups   | Swords  | Pentacles  |

| Fire   | Water  | Air   | Earth  |
| Work, enterprise, ideas; the energies fo the spiritual plane or archetypal world (Platos's world of ideas) | desires, hopes, wishes, emotional activities; the states and forces of the mental plane, the creative world in which mental patterns are formulated. | Action, and therefore the conflict of forces; the states and activities of the astral plane, the formative world of unseen forces which build the physical plane. | Things, possessions, the concrete objects and bodies of the physical plane; the objectification of the energies and forces of the higher worlds or planes represented by Wands, Cups, Swords |

- Fire & Water are Enemies and Weaken Each other
- Air & Earth are Enemies and Weaken Each other
- All others are friendly and supportive
- Fire & Air are active
- Water and Earth are passive






